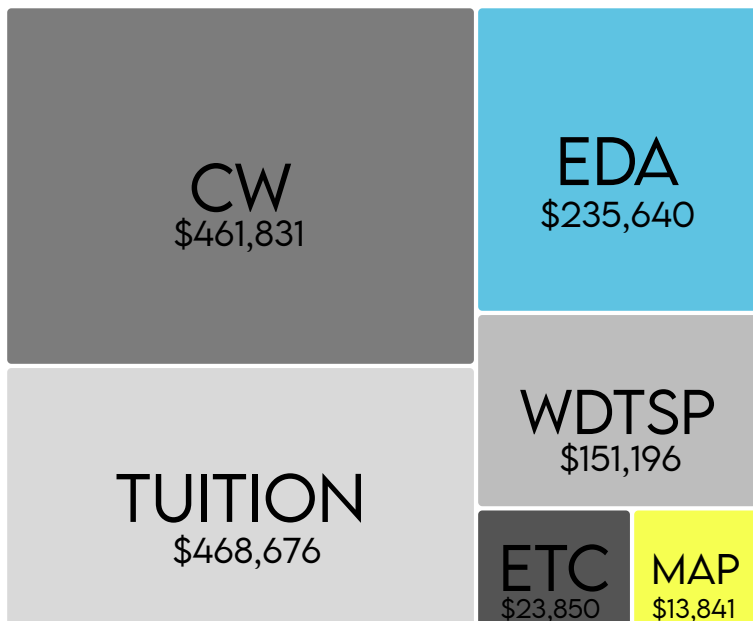

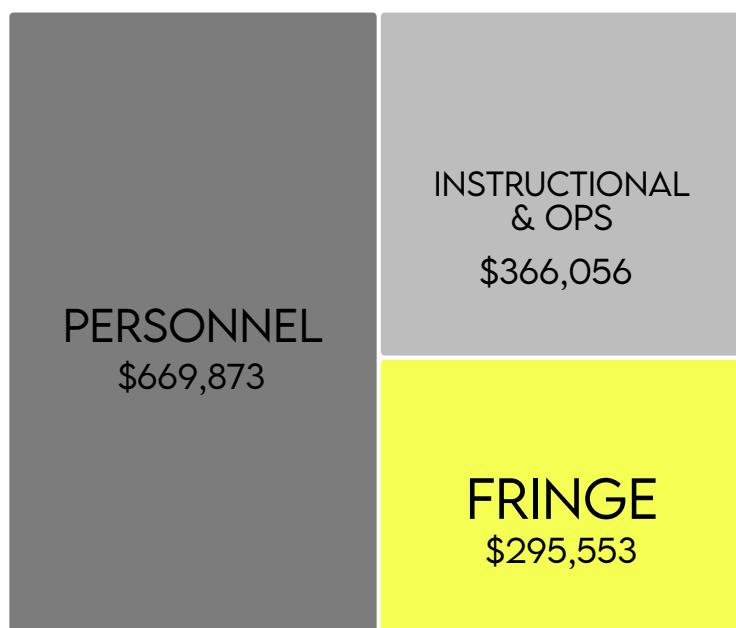

### GENERAL EXPENSES

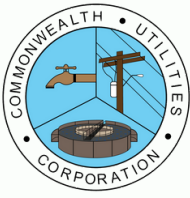
