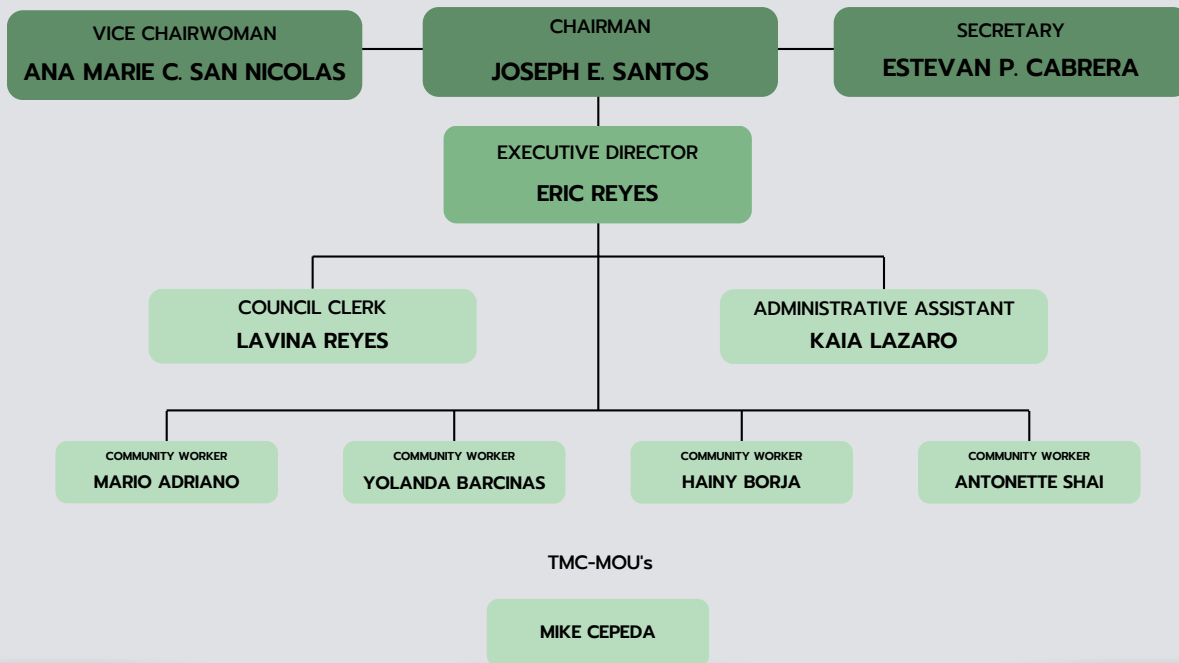
MISSION

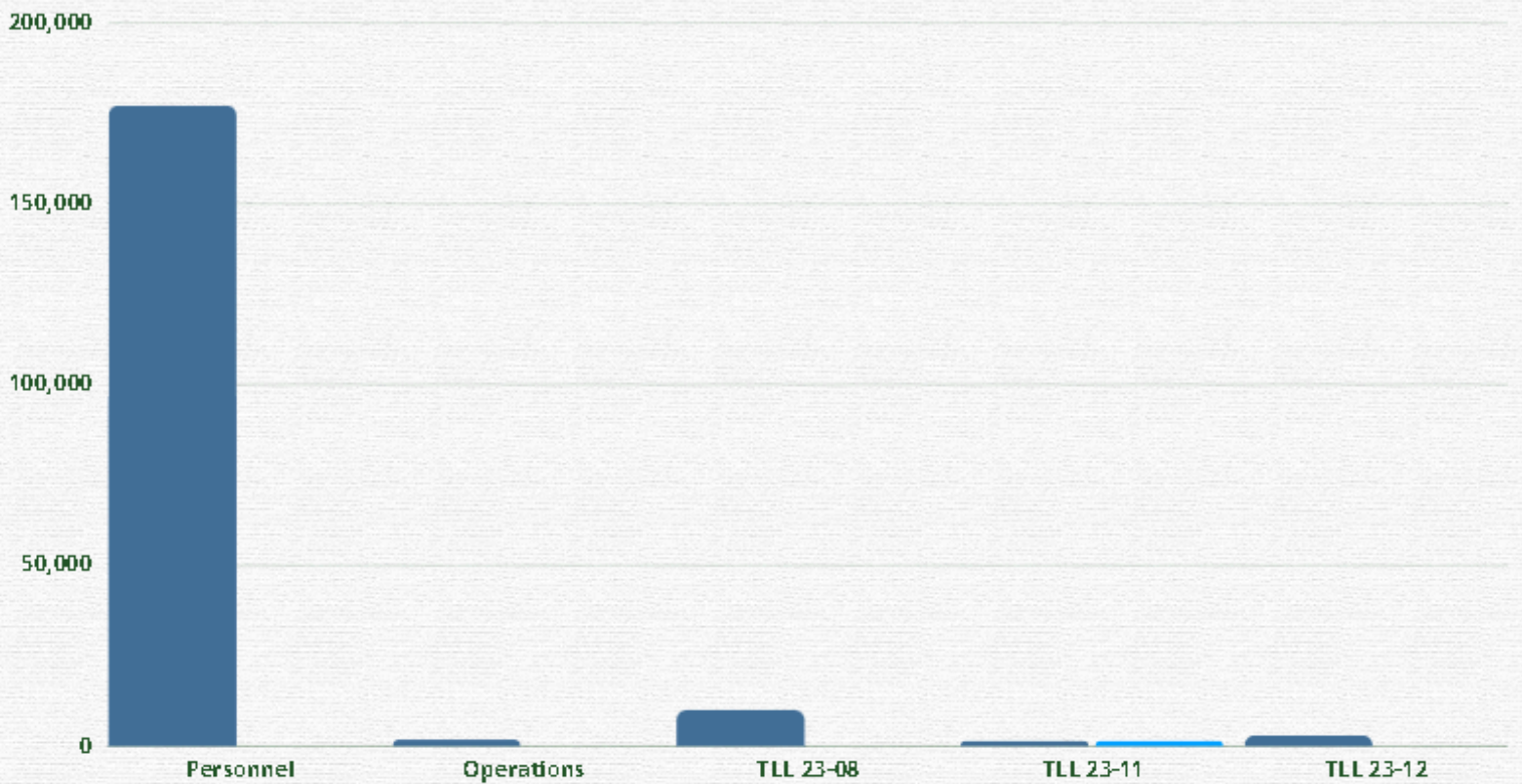
