2024 CITIZEN CENTRIC REPORT

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The Department of Fire and Emergency Medical Services (DFEMS) in the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands (CNMI) is a state agency, organized primarily to provide efficient and effective firefighting, fire protection, fire investigation, emergency medical services, specialized rescue, handling of hazardous material, and wildland firefighting services to persons and property on the Island of Rota.

DFEMS Rota is spearheaded by Resident Deputy Commissioner Glenn L. Maratita and is comprised of two divisions; Operations and Administration. Under the Operations Division, we have Emergency Services; Alpha, Bravo and Charlie shifts, HAZMAT, SARU and Forestry, Emergency Medical Services and Division of Fire Prevention and Arson Investigation. This division is designed to respond to all 911 calls needing Fire and Emergency Medical Services. Under the Administration Division we have the Administrative Section, Logistics & Supply, and Training & Development. Furthermore, this division is responsible to plan, coordinate and resource training to ensure all firefighters are certified and up to standards with the required training. Lastly, this division handles all administrative needs for the department, to include personnel, payroll, procurement and outreach programs.
