## VISION

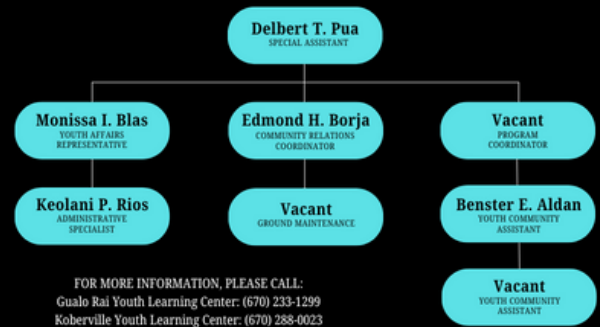

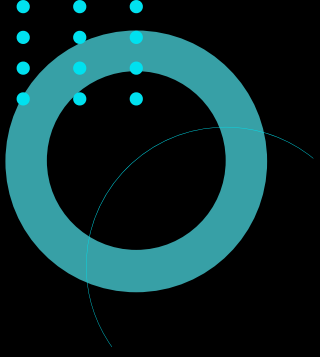

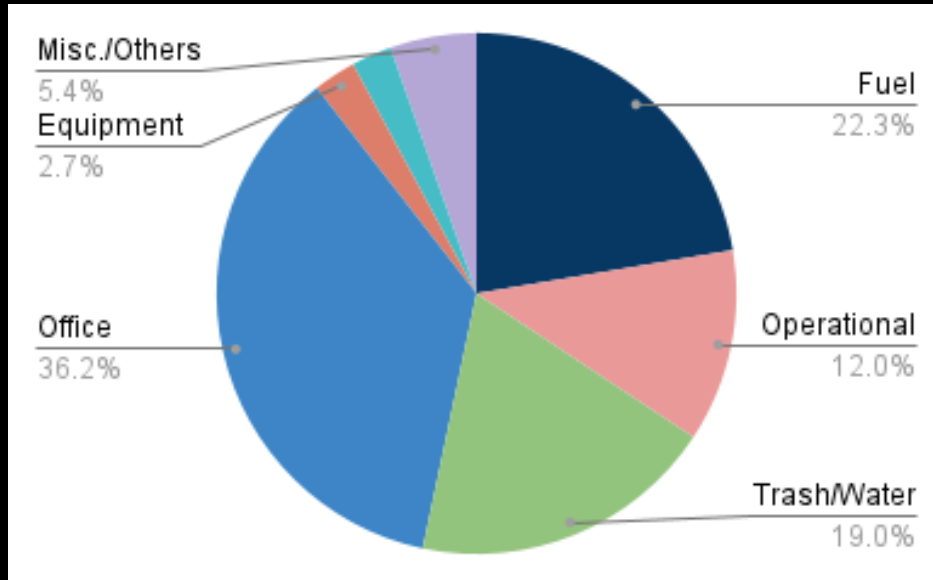

## FINANCES / EXPENSES



- In accordance with the FY 2025 Revised Governor's Budget Proposal, 5 out of 8 FTE personnel remain funded under the PL 23-26 for FY 2025. 3 vacancies remain.
- On-going cost containment efforts and strategies implemented within our operating centers (GR and Koblerville).
- \$5,000.00 awarded under Project SL071 for purchasing of sports equipment for the youth centers.

- Provide access to youth services for all children and youth in places and spaces that are accessible, modern, attractive, and well-resourced.
- Develop effective partnership with providers and youth-serving agencies to enhance youth programs and services in our community.
